Kids Classes are a Semester enrollment. This allows for consistency in their learning and the ability to work towards a performance at the end of Semester 1 (term 1 & 2) and Semester 2 (term 3 & 4). Enrollment is open throughout the year, however, students must begin regular classes at least 10 weeks before the performance date if they wish to perform at showcases.

Classes run inline with school terms and have holidays off. Classes will run on all public holidays except for Easter weekend.

Family discounts on the third child may be available. Please contact the studio to discuss.

# Payment

Payment is to be made upfront unless organising a payment plan through Mindbody. Please note that no payment plans are available via any other methods.

For upfront payments: Mindbody, bank transfer, cash or card options are available. Please note that all payments are non-refundable or transferrable.

## Payment Plans

Payment plans are available to make budgeting easy and give everyone the opportunity to access circus classes.

The two payment plans available are:

- 1 Class Per Week - 4x fortnightly payments - total amount due \$500
- 2 Classes Per Week - 5x fortnightly payments - total amount due \$875

### Missed Payment Fee

A \$5 missed payment fee will be automatically charged immediately for any missed payments and this will be charged each week that the payment remains outstanding.

**Students will not be able to participate in class until all overdue payments are made.**

Please note that **when you sign up to a payment plan you are agreeing to pay the FULL amount and any accounts in arrears will be referred to a debt collector. Please read the terms and conditions carefully.** If you cannot afford the full amount, casual class options are available.



# Changes to Enrollment

## Cooling Off Period

All kids and preschool classes have a 2 week cooling off period from the day of purchase where you can cancel and receive a refund minus a \$25 administration fee and any classes your child might have attended, which will be converted to and charged at the casual rate of \$30 per class.

You must notify the studio via email your cancellation request within the 2 week cooling period.

## Class Change

There is a \$10 administration fee for class changes. You must notify the studio via email with your change request.

*eg. You can no longer make Saturday circus and want to attend Tuesday pole instead*

## Withdrawal/Cancellation of Enrollment

If your circumstances change and you wish to cancel entirely please be aware of our 30 day notice cancellation policy. All cancellation requests are to be submitted via email only.

We do not provide monetary refunds for booked semesters, but we will provide 50% of the remaining credit onto your account with a 2 year expiry date so that you can return at any time within the 2 years and use that credit.

# Attendance/Make-ups

## Late Arrival

It is your responsibility to ensure that students arrive on time dressed in the appropriate attire. If a student is more than **5 minutes late they may not be allowed to participate in the class.** Circus is a dangerous activity and late attendance may mean that your child has missed out on the warmup and important information. Inconsistent attendance can affect student's advancement and remove their opportunity of performing with the class.

## Make-up Lessons

Make-up lessons are available when a **minimum of 12 hours notice** of your child's absence is received by the studio - this is considered an early cancellation. You can notify the studio of your absence via phone call (voicemail is acceptable in the event of a missed call), text message or email. Make-up lessons must be taken **within 2 weeks** of the missed class.

Please note - if you notify the teacher in person, a followup message is still required or the early cancellation may not be actioned.

Cancellations within the 12 hour period are considered a late cancellation and the credit is forfeit. No tuition rates will be changed, refunded or transferred for absences.

# What to Wear

Aerials students should wear long tights (activewear) or dance shorts with footless dance tights underneath. Either a leotard or tshirt with sleeves, that can be tucked in and a crop top (where relevant) on the top. This is to ensure adequate coverage of their bodies and protection of their skin on aerials. The backs of the knees, waist and armpits are most at risk of being burnt or grazing during aerials activities.

Pole students need to wear dance shorts, a crop top (where relevant) and their choice of tshirt or tank top. Skin is important for grip on the pole, without it you would simply slide to the ground.

Acro and dance students may wear any of the above.

**Hair should be worn off the face and fastened securely.** This is important for safety. We don't want your child to get tangled, scalped or hurt because of their hair. Hair back allows for full visibility and freedom of movement.

Please consider your child's safety and modesty when they are coming to class. Eg. If they insist on wearing a skirt, make sure they have shorts underneath.

Each teacher may have additional specifications for clothing.

Permanent jewellery must be taped with sports tape. Should the studio need to tape the jewellery, this service is available for \$5 each occasion.

# Parent/Guardian & Student Behaviour

Newcastle Pole & Aerials Academy and Newie Circus Cats are a place of support and empowerment. All parents, carers, students and any guests are expected to behave in a polite and respectful way towards staff and their peers.

Students should have positive attitudes towards themselves and their training and be supportive, bringing a mature and friendly attitude to classes.

NPAA is committed to providing a professional environment free of discrimination and harassment in all of its activities and operations. This is aimed at preventing all forms of disrespectful behaviours and decisions which could contribute to a discriminatory or hostile environment for NPAA members and supporters. It includes harassment and discrimination based on gender, race, colour, religion, national origin, mental or physical disabilities, age, sexual orientation, pregnancy, medical condition, and family or marital status.

Parents, carers, students and friends being disruptive and unfriendly to staff or other students will be given 3 warnings before their enrolment is withdrawn and they will be required to wait until the following year to be considered for re-enrolment.

**Absolutely ZERO tolerance will be given for abusive, threatening or violent behaviour.**

In instances where behaviour is aggressive, threatening or goes against studio policies, instant dismissal and a police report may be made.

## Parent/Guardian Observation

There is strictly **no availability for parent observation during classes**. We ask that parents wait in the foyer, or outside or you may drop off and pick up. At the end of each class (last 10min), parents/carers may have the opportunity to see some of the things students have been working on. Please note we do not always have the capacity to accommodate this.

**Please DO NOT give instruction to any students on how to complete a skill.** You are not trained or insured by the studio and this can result in serious injury to the student or others. If you see unsafe practices or have any concerns please raise this with management.

**No Heckling!** People laugh and are shocked when we say this one, but it happens all the time. Heckling includes telling your child to get up and “do the thing”. Circus is hard and dangerous. If you are concerned about your child's participation in class, please talk to the instructor after class and we can figure out strategies to get the most out of classes whilst maintaining a safe and positive environment.

The opportunity to take photos and videos will be available at different times throughout the term, please check with the instructor first. **DO NOT film or photograph another person's child** unless given express permission by the student and their parent/guardian.

Exception to the no observation rule:

Parents & Kittens (1.5-3yrs) - Parents are expected to assist child's participation in class and will be guided by the instructor on how to best support your child in the space.

Circus Kittens (3-4yrs) - New children may require closer support in their first 2-4 weeks of class. By weeks 5-8 you should be able to sit back, further away in the space/in the foyer. By weeks 9-10, you should be able to wait in the foyer, outside or upstairs in a free pole room.

If you feel that your child requires extra support, please talk to us! We want to work with you, not against you to give your child the best experience possible!
